

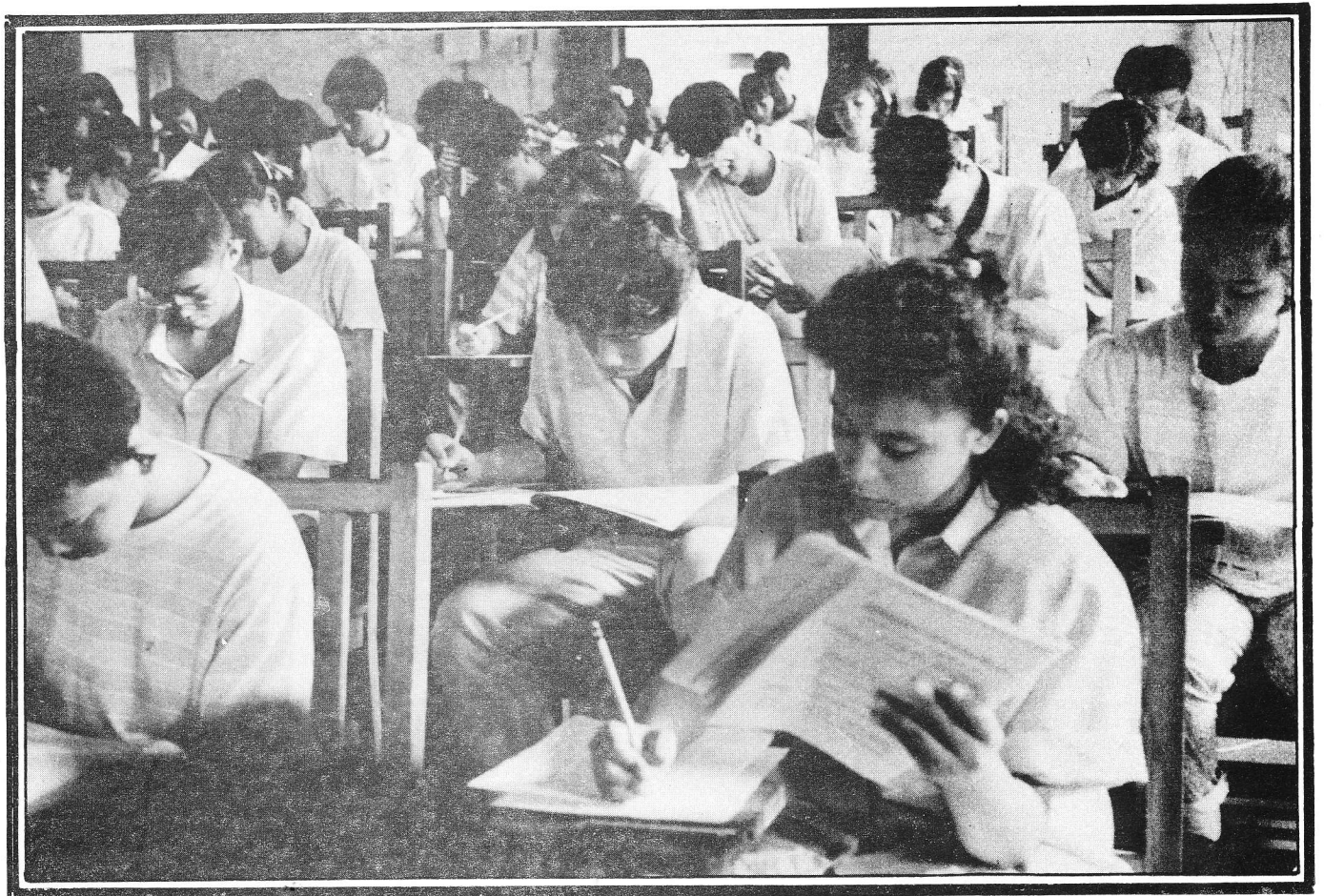

**SUBJECT:** Creation of a Subcommittee to Streamline the Administration of the UPCAT

Please constitute yourselves into a subcommittee of the UPCAS Review Committee (Administrative Order No. 1, dated 2 January 1989). The specific task of this Subcommittee shall be to study the present methods of administering the UPCAT in order to make it more efficient with a view toward reducing the number of manpower and budget required and being able to release the UPCAT results much faster than they are being released now.

At present, the UPCAT project has an annual budget of about P3.0M involving the full-time involvement of at least 50 people. Of these 50, 25 have just been classified as contractual U.P. personnel funded from the UPCAT Trust Fund. The other 25 are still classified as project personnel funded from UPCAT funds in the U.P. Foundation, but it is likely that they too will be recommended for inclusion as contractual U.P. employees. The absorption of 50 personnel into the University runs counter to a long-time policy of reducing our non-faculty complement. It is to be noted that at present, the Diliman Registrar's Office already has 60 full-time people, apart from those 50 in the UPCAT project.

At present, the UPCAT is administered in October but the results are not released until the first week of April. The Board of Regents wishes that the period be shortened so that results can be released much earlier.

Do coordinate your work with the UPCAS Review Committee but your specific emphasis will be on making UPCAT procedures more efficient. Please complete your study by end of February or a little later. It is understood that in finalizing your recommendations, you shall be consulting not only the Registrar's Office but also the UPCAS Review Committee.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2**

**SUBJECT:** Creation of a coordinating committee for the planning

WHEREAS, the Board of Regents in its meeting of 8 December 1988 approved the establishment of a University Center for Women's Studies;

WHEREAS, a Committee has to be created to plan and implement the activities towards the formal establishment of the Center by 1990;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **JOSE V. ABUEVA**, President of the University of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Board of Regents, do hereby create a Coordinating Committee for the Planning and Establishment of a University Center for Women's Studies which shall be responsible for realizing the objectives set forth in this Order.

**Section 1. Creation of a Coordinating Committee**

There is hereby created a Coordinating Committee for the Planning and Establishment of a University Center for Women's Studies, hereinafter referred to as the Coordinating Committee, with the following members:

**Section 2. Functions.** The Coordinating Committee shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

1. To conceptualize and recommend the objectives, functions and responsibilities and organizational structure of a University Center for Women's Studies, hereinafter referred to as Center, to be created within the University of the Philippines and based in the Diliman Campus.
2. To identify sources of financial, technical and personnel support for the Center.
3. To identify prospective faculty members and other staff who shall serve the Center and define their respective roles and responsibilities.
4. To draw up a five-year plan for the Center.
5. To develop research proposals, prepare informational brochures, and conduct workshops pursuant to the objectives of the Center.
6. To perform such other functions as are related to the above or as may be further assigned by the President.

**Section 3. Creation of Subcommittees.** The Coordinating Committee is hereby empowered to create such other subcommittees to be composed of its members or non-members as it may deem necessary to assist it in the performance of its functions. For this purpose, it may call on any faculty or staff of the University as may find necessary.

**Section 4. Term of the Coordinating Committee.** The Coordinating Committee shall serve for the period of 9 December 1988 to 3 December 1989 or until it shall have fulfilled its functions.

**Section 5. Funding.** To provide support to the Coordinating Committee in the performance of its function, the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) is hereby made available to cover expenses incurred in the conduct of its meetings or other activities.

**Section 6. Effectivity.** The Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.

### Cover story

This is the theme of the 1988 Community Christmas Festival which began on Dec. 16 with various activities, culminating in the traditional Christmas Lantern Parade.

The Lantern Parade is an annual event held in the University. It began in 1922 as an adaptation of a Filipino custom during the Spanish time of using lanterns of different shapes and sizes to light the way of the church-goers attending the early-morning mass.

The University President also gives his traditional Christmas Message during this time. "Tradition," he said, "are the repetition of ceremonies and rituals which appear unchanged through the years. Actually, it only the form that is the same. The content changes and that content reflects the evolving values and attitudes of society."

According to Pres. Abueva, the lantern parade has changed from "a simple and happy affair celebrating the end of classes and the advent of a holiday season of grace to a full blown expression of protest against a dictator."

This year's lantern parade "expresses our people's almost desperate yearning for peace same as last year when it seemed possible under the spirit of reconciliation," he said. Pres. Abueva also called upon the UP Faculty, students and administrative personnel "to rally for a cease-fire and for peace talks leading to a just, honorable and enduring peace."

The Board **approved** the request for reinstatement of Mr. Mangaoil. Such reinstatement, however, shall be without claim to back wages.

### Grant of Package of Incentives to transferees to UP Iloilo (Miagao Campus)

The Board **approved** the amendment of the board resolution dated 24 March 1987 granting a package of incentive to transferees to UP Iloilo (Miagao Campus)

### Disposition of UP Land Grants under the Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program

The Board **approved** the recommendations in regard to the land grants. The University shall also discuss its proposal with the DAR

Agricultural Cooperatives in the land grant area.

The Board **approved** the grant for another two (2) years of housing and dependent's allowances to 15 former employees of UP Basilan Land Grant who were transferred to UP Visayas in July 1984.

The Board **approved** the establishment of Trust Funds for UP Press and UP Computer Center.

### Distribution of 60% of the Tuition Fee Increase Collected during Summer 1988, 1st and 2nd Semesters of AY 1988-89

The Board **approved** the distribution of 60% of the tuition fee increase collected during Summer 1988, 1st and 2nd Semesters of AY 1988-89.

### Increase in Honoraria/Allowances

The Board **approved** the increase in honoraria/allowances for coaches and athletes, SPEAR, UP Diliman; for members of the UP Press Board of Management, UP Diliman; for the indexer, UP Press; laundry allowance; for professors emeriti and out-of-station allowances of Rural Development officers (RDO) under the Agricultural Development Program for the Countryside.

  - a) Rehabilitation of airconditioning facilities of UPLB, particularly of the Main Library.
  - b) Supplementary Miscellaneous Fund of UP Diliman.
3. The CY 1987 equipment allocation under the General Fund of the College for the purchase of equipment in the amount of P6,330.
